Paragraph 8	Delete the last sentence from “Another” in second line to the end of the paragraph. In this way, paragraph 8 will be as following. <i>8. This intervention led to some discussion on the point of potential inadequacies and/or gaps in both governmental guidelines and the AHTEG guidance on risk assessment.</i>	The last sentence of the paragraph 8 is just an speculation!
Paragraph 30	Replace “Some” instead of the first word of the paragraph (“many”) and in this way, paragraph 30 will be as following. <i>30. <u>Some</u> submitters noted that the voluntary guidance produced by the AHTEG is a useful tool...</i>	
Paragraph 32	Replace “Some” instead of the first words of the paragraph (“A few”) and in this way, paragraph 32 will be as following. <i>32. <u>Some</u> submitters noted the view that there were some ...</i>	
Paragraph 44	Replace “Some” instead of the first words of the paragraph (“A few”) and in this way, paragraph 44 will be as following. <i>44. <u>Some</u> interventions mentioned the need for a benefit assessment to be ...</i>	
Paragraph 60	Delete the words (“more strongly”) in the middle of the first line of the paragraph. In this way, paragraph 60 will be as following.
