Bulgarian Ministry of Environment and Water examined the "Elements of a Framework for Conceptual Clarity on Socio-Economic Considerations" contained in annex to Notification 2015-007. We approve the document developed by the Ad Hoc Technical Expert Group on Socioeconomic considerations. It provides a good basis for the future work in that area in the context of Cartagena protocol on Biosafety.

We would like to propose the following technical changes in the document:

- 1. Living modified organisms on can have direct or indirect, beneficial or detrimental effects on plant and animal health with significant economic and social consequences. Such effects may not necessarily be addressed in risk assessment that focuses on human health and effects on the environment. Animal and plant health-related issues should be included at following three places in the document:
- a) General principles, point 6;
- b) Methodological considerations, point 1 Scope, last dot;
- c) Points to consider, point 5, first paragraph.
- 2. Public opinion surveys as a cost effective and informative approach to investigate socioeconomic considerations. As such it should be included in Methodological considerations, point 2 Methodological approaches, fifth dot.
