Concerning point 6, we would like to call your attention on what kind of issues we are considering when

we take into account human health related issues, because we have to bear in mind that risk

assessment process includes human health issues.

Talking about point 7, we would like to discuss why do we have to use that kind of precautionary

principle when it has already been covered with the risk assessment process.

Finally, we are concerned about the "Methodological considerations" that contain the issues about

"cultural / traditional / religious / ethical" methodologies, because we believe they are under individual

decision right. For instance, the first two (Cultural / traditional) could be an obstacle for innovation. The

next two (religious / ethical) should not depend on the tool type considered, but how these tools are

used by each farmer.
