Scenario:

You are a newspaper journalist working in Thailand and you have just received an anonymous tip that some genetically modified cattle have escaped from a facility in Cambodia and crossed the border into Thailand. Use the BCH as a tool to assist you in researching this event.

Hint: you should be able to confirm if the event has been reported; get some contacts to follow up; check if the countries in question are Parties to the Protocol; look for information about the genetically modified organism; and find some contacts to follow up if you later need an expert consultation.
