











## Possible capacity needs (human, institutional, technical...)

**Administrative** 

Maintain data on activities involving LMOs

Maintain data on operators

Develop and maintain data on biological diversity

Develop and maintain criteria on monitoring and evaluation of damage to biological diversity and human health

Maintain a mechanism for notifying and consulting with affected or potentially affected states in the event of incidents

Implement appropriate response measures

## Possible capacity needs (human, institutional, technical...)

Information sharing/ awareness

Inform operators of their obligations and available remedies

Promote public awareness and education concerning damage to biological diversity resulting from LMOs

Make available information to the BCH on incidents of damage to biological diversity and appropriate response measures taken or to be taken

Compile and make available information on the availability of insurance or other mechanisms to cover liability for environmental damage or damage to biological diversity
