



COP-MOP 6

Liability and redress (Operational Objective 1.5)

> To consider the status of signature, ratification or accession to the Nagoya – Kuala Lumpur Supplementary Protocol on Liability and Redress to the Biosafety Protocol.

Assessment and Review (Operational Objective 3.2)

>This assessment and review will focus primarily on evaluating the status of implementation of core elements of the Protocol – whether domestic regulatory frameworks consistent with the Protocol are in place and operational.

Multi-year programme of work (cont'd)

COP-MOP 7

Liability and redress (Operational objectives 1.5 & 2.4)

> To consider the status of implementation of the Supplementary Protocol.

Information sharing and the BCH (Operational objective 4.1)

> To review the overall operation of the BCH including access to and retrieval of information by users.



COP-MOP 8

Liability and redress (Operational objective 2.4)

>To review the need for any guidance or assistance to Parties in their efforts to establish and apply the Supplementary Protocol and/or and national rules and procedures on liability and redress related to living modified organisms.

Multi-year programme of work (cont'd)

Programme of work will be adjusted on the basis of:

- reperience gained in the implementation of the requirements of the Protocol;
- the result of the periodic assessment and review of the effectiveness of the Protocol as provided for in Article 35 of the Protocol.
