The word participation is used through Objectives, Indicators and Outcomes, and so given that consultation and participation are not the same thing, participation should be used in Goals and Objectives for clarity and consistency.
14	Goal B.3.	Insert 'all according to the highest ethical standards of research and public participation' at end of existing sentence. This is especially important in light of the new technologies like gene drives, which in places like Burkina Faso are being tested through the use of human subjects in the case of Target Malaria, raising severe ethical problems.
14	Objectives B.3.3	Replace 'consult' with 'participation' for consistency with other Objectives and the Indicators.
